

HOW TO ACCESS



Available for students, faculty, and staff

eduroam is a secure, world-wide roaming Wi-Fi access service developed for the international research and education community. *eduroam* works through connecting to the campus network locally and allows access in Internet connectivity when visiting other participating institutions.

NOTE: Users visiting our campus from other participating institutions will also be able to access the Internet using their own credentials.

HOW TO CONNECT

The first time you connect to the *eduroam* wireless network at your home campus/site, you will need to configure your device. After the initial configuration, the network will allow you to connect wherever it is supported. Please refer to your home campus/site's instructions.

- 1** When you are visiting a participating institution, select *eduroam* from the available wireless networks on your device.
- 2** To log in, enter your credentials, which may vary depending on your home campus/site's instructions (i.e., full email address as your user name and campus password).
- 3** If prompted, accept the *eduroam* certificate.

4 EASY STEPS

TO ACCESS THE BEACHNET GUEST WIRELESS NETWORK

Guests of the university can obtain WiFi access for a single day while on campus by following these steps. Device types will vary, but the basic process is essentially the same.

- 1** Open up your device's WiFi settings and click on "beach-guest-access" network.
- 2** Open any web browser, which will automatically open the beachnet-guest-access WiFi log-in page.
- 3** Click on the blue "Self-register" link to create a one-day guest WiFi access pass. It will take the user through the steps, which will require a personal email address.
- 4** Access your provided email address to obtain the temporary guest access username and password, and return to the Beachnet Guest Access page to log in.
